Maintenance Check List

Properly maintaining your belt sander will keep it function. Below is a list of items that you will need to do to keep it functioning. These tasks should be performed monthly (depending on usage of the machine).

Check List

Thoroughly clean sander and coolant tank. We would recommend disassembling the sander to complete procedure, but not required. We also recommend changing the coolant frequently (follow manufactures recommendations).

This involves blowing with air nozzle or a stiff bristle brush to knock off debris on all moving parts. Below are the moving parts:

- Upper Pulley (560-016IPA)
- Drive Pulley (560-015)
- Tension shaft (700-004)
- Frame (291-018)
- Lever (455-003)
- Tension spring (697-024)
- Coupling assembly (148-001)
