Setup Checklist

- **Workspace**: Locate the saw on a stable workbench in a well-lit, ventilated area.
- **Assembly**: Carefully follow Kalamazoo's instructions for your specific model, installing the blade guard, vise, and other accessories.
- Power: Connect to a compatible power source (check your saw's specifications).
- Coolant (Wet saws): Fill the coolant reservoir to the appropriate level.

Safety Essentials

- **Protective Gear:** Wear safety glasses, hearing protection, and a dust mask. Gloves and closed-toe shoes are also good practice.
- Clean Work Area: Keep your workspace clear and organized.
- Choose the Blade: Install the correct abrasive blade type for the material you'll be cutting. Your saw's manual and blade markings will guide you.
- Guards in Place: Never operate the saw without safety guards correctly installed.

Basic Cutting Technique

- Clamp it Down: Securely clamp your workpiece in the saw's vise.
- Mark and Align: Ensure your cut mark is aligned with the blade's path.
- Power Up: Start the saw, letting the blade reach full speed.
- Gentle Feed: Apply steady pressure as you guide the material into the blade. Don't force it!

Always Remember

- Practice Makes Perfect: Start by cutting scrap material until you're comfortable with the saw's handling.
- **Maintenance Matters:** Keep your saw clean, change dull blades, and follow the maintenance schedule to ensure its longevity.
